Patient and user rights act

§ 5-1.Right to access journal

The patient and user has right to access their journal with appendixes, and are entitled to receive a copy upon request. The patient and user are entitled to a brief and understandable explanation of terminology or similar.

The patient and user can be denied access to information in the journal, when strictly necessary, to prevent risk of life or serious health damage for the patient or user him/herself, or access to information is clearly inadvisable for the sake of persons close to the patient and user.

A representative for the patient or user has the right to access information when the patient or user is denied access, unless the representative is considered unfit. A doctor or attorney can not be denied access, unless there are particular reasons to do so.

§ 3-3 and § 3-4 regarding others right to access information are similar for access to journal.

Next of kin has the right to access journal after a patient or users death, unless there are particular reasons not to do so.

The Ministry may, in regulations, issue further provisions on the right of access to the journal, including provisions on payment for copies.

Eg. one copy of a journal is free - upon request for multiple copies, a fee of NOK 100 is paid, which will cover expenses and postage.

3-4. Information when the patient is a minor

If the patient is under the age of 16, both the patient and the parents or others with parental responsibility should be informed.

If the patient is between 12 and 16 years old, information shall not be given to parents or others with parental rights when the patient, for reasons that should be respected, does not consent.

Information deemed necessary to fulfill parental responsibility, shall nevertheless be given to parents or others with parental rights when the patient is under the age of 18.

If child protection services are in care of a child under the age of 16 following the child welfare act § 4-8 or § 4-12, the first, second and third paragraphs apply correspondingly to the child welfare service.

Journal copies that are sent by mail, are sent to the registered address in the National Population Register.
